

About The Lion King

The Lion King Jr. is the story of Simba, an adventurous and energetic lion cub, who is next in line to be king of the Pride Lands and Pride Rock in the African Savanna. When Simba's father, Mufasa, is killed by his Uncle Scar, Simba is led to believe that his father's death is his own fault, and he is encouraged to run away forever. Scar seizes power of the Pride Lands, leading to Hyenas being allowed to overhunt, robbing the Pride Lands of its natural resources. With the help of new friends and old, Simba embarks on a dangerous journey to reclaim the throne and his rightful title of King.
